


#### General

- No tools are required for the assembly. A team of 2 people is recommended for assembly and disassembly.
- For Intex boat models: MARINER 3 & 4, EXCURSION 4, CHALLENGER 3, and SEAHAWK 3 & 4.
- Make sure the boat is setup and inflated first. The boat must be on dry land when installing the canopy to the boat.
- · Stow the canopy when cruising at high speed.
- · Never attempt to setup this product during strong winds, thunderstorms, heavy rain or snow.


#### Setup instructions

#### 1. Frame Assembly

1.1 Connect the end of the J-shaped rods (2) marked "A" to the crossbar (1) ends marked "A". Make sure the spring pin is securely snapped into the hole. See Fig 1.




**1.2** Connect the straight rods **(3)** to the folding joint with mounting brackets **(4)**. Make sure the spring pin is securely snapped into the hole. See Fig 2.




#### 2. Installing the canopy to the frame

**2.1** Spread out the canopy **(6)** and slide the crossbar assembly into the canopy sleeve. Repeat this procedure for the other canopy sleeve. Adjust the canopy so that it's centered over the crossbar assembly. See Fig 3.1-3.2.






2.2 Attach the crossbar assembly with the canopy to the folding joint with mounting bracket assembly. Make sure the spring pin is securely snapped into the hole. IMPORTANT: The canopy side with the "black pull tab" must be facing down or inward. See Fig 4.



#### 3. Installing the canopy assembly to the boat


3.1 For Intex Mariner 3 & 4 models: locate the rope holders with "double holes" on the sides of the hull near the front of the boat. With the "short" side of the crossbar assembly facing the front of the boat, attached the canopy assembly mounting brackets to the rope holders with double holes. Pull the safety pin first then release the pin so that it's securely latched onto the rope holder and the mounting bracket. Repeat the process with the other side. See Fig 5.



3.2 For Intex Excursion 4, Seahawk 3 & 4 and Challenger 3 models: With the tall side of the crossbar assembly facing the front of the boat, attached the canopy assembly mounting brackets to the oar holders located on the sides of the hull near the back of the boat. Pull the safety pin first then release the pin so that it's securely latched onto the oar holder and the mounting bracket. Repeat the process with the other side. See Fig 6.



3.3 Fasten the 4 hooks located at the end of the canopy straps to the rope holders located on the sides of the hull. Check that the canopy is centered and stretched out. Adjust the straps buckles to tighten the canopy. See Fig 7.



#### Maintenance and long term storage

- 1. Regularly check all components for sign of damage, and wear and tear. Replace damaged components immediately.
- 2. Reverse the above setup instructions to disassemble the canopy.
- 3. Use a sponge and fresh water to wipe away any soil or stains on the canopy.
- 4. Make sure all components are completely dry before storage.
- 5. Store the canopy and accessories in a dry, temperature controlled, between  $0^{\circ} 40^{\circ}$ C (32°  $104^{\circ}$ F), storage location.
- 6. The original packing can be used for storage.
